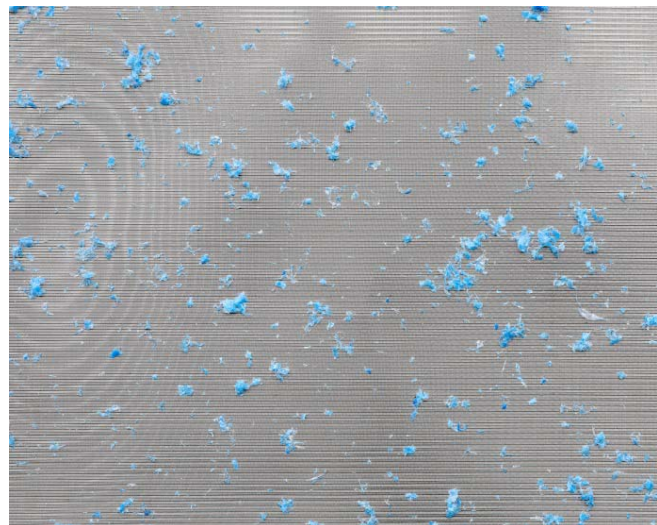

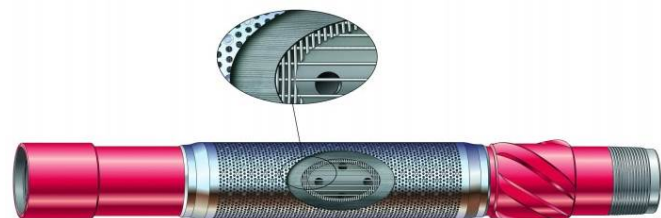

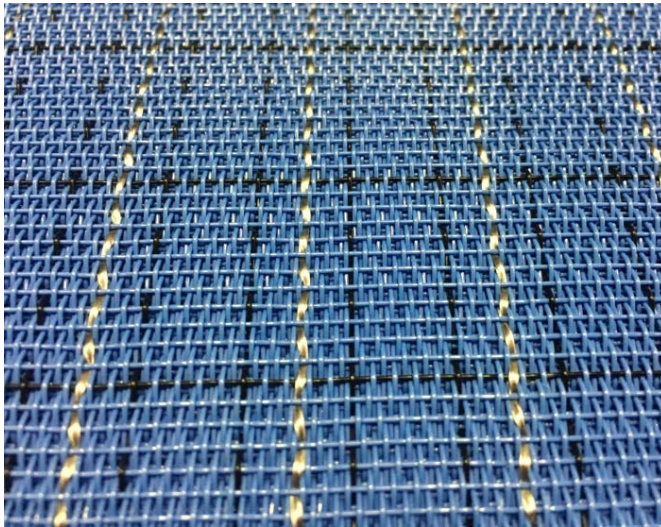
Picture 3: In the crude oil industry, constructions with GKD mesh gained further ground as mandatory requirements in the tender specifications of leading oilfield service companies.

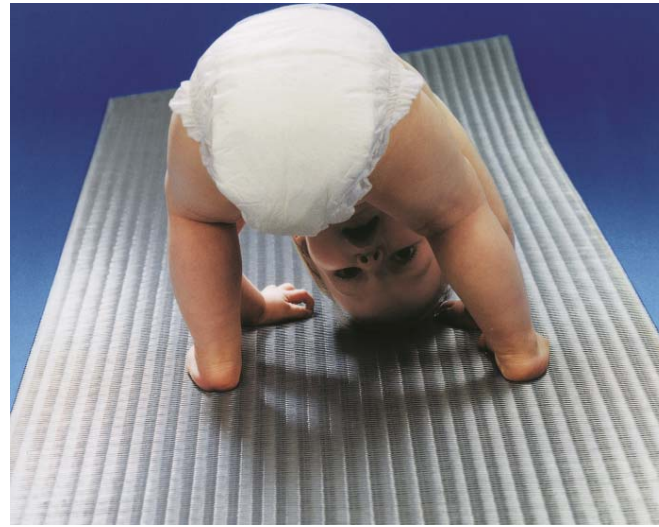

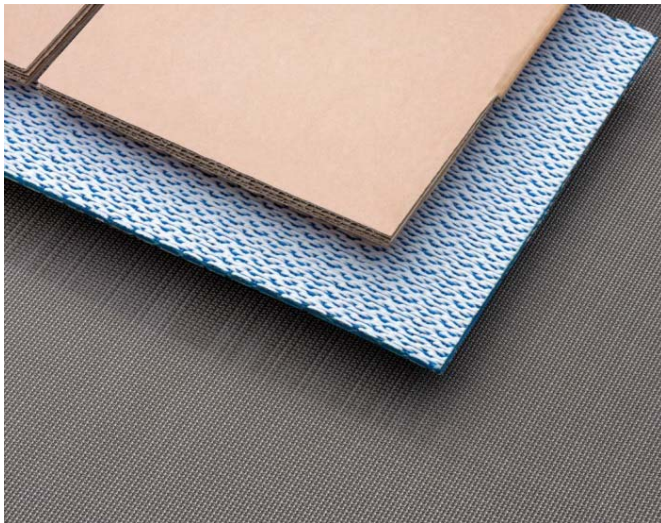

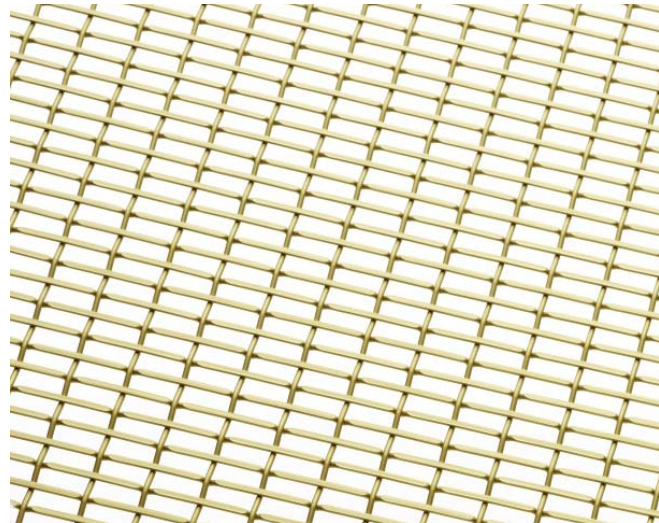
